The members will join nearly 6,000 conference delegates from across the nation to compete in national level business skills competitions and attend leadership development, workshops, general sessions, and national officer candidate campaigns and elections.

The Garaway Accounting program will also send one student to nationals in Payroll Accounting. Eric Gordon placed third at state.

All above students will have the opportunity to compete at nationals and learn from leading business professionals.
