BUCKEYE CAREER CENTER WINS FREE TEXTBOOK SUBSCRIPTIONS FOR ONE YEAR

New Philadelphia, OH (May 22, 2018) – Buckeye Career Center students enrolled in transportation labs will benefit from one instructor’s contest entry at the Ohio SkillsUSA State Championships. Outdoor Power Equipment Technology instructor John Resh entered Goodheart-Willcox Publisher’s drawing for free online textbooks for a year and was chosen as the winner from hundreds of entries. Katrina Pelow with Goodheart-Willcox made the trip to Buckeye Career Center Monday, May 21, 2018 to present Resh with the classroom copy of four books, including *Small Gas Engines*, *Basic Mathematics*, *Two-Stroke Engines*, and *Math for Automotive Technicians*. Pelow says the contest benefits schools, while also helping her company remain current with what schools and instructors need. “If an instructor wins this they’re going to request books that they are interested in and it gives us an opportunity to learn about what they want and their students, too,” said Pelow. Resh was ecstatic to be chosen as the winner and is pleased that the books will benefit many of the transportation labs at BCC. “The math books will especially be used in other labs. So they will be helpful for elsewhere, like Ag & Deisel Technology,” said Resh. Pelow stated that students and instructors will have online access to the textbooks, which also includes related workbooks and instructor resource suites. She estimates that the normal cost to a school district for such supplies would cost \$600-\$800 annually.
