Location, Date, and Time:

Students will need to be on stage at the KSU Tuscarawas Performing Arts Center by 6:15 p.m. for seating on the stage. Seating will be arranged by Career Technical programs, and the students' name cards will be found on their chairs. Guidance and administrative staff will be present to assist students in finding their seats. It is important that students carry the name cards with them as it will be used to announce their names during the ceremony.

Ticket Information

In order to attend the Awards Ceremony, attendees will need tickets to enter the KSU Tuscarawas Performing Arts Center. There is no charge for the tickets, and each student will be able to receive up to five (5) tickets. Included in this letter, you will find a reservation form to request your tickets. On this reservation form, we ask that you register your guests for the evening by filling out their names and returning the form with your student to the BCC High School office **by 3:00 p.m. on Friday, April 29, 2022**. Information on additional tickets, if available, will be communicated to families after **Monday, May 9, 2022**.

Requirements for Participation

In order for a student to be eligible to participate in the Awards Ceremony, he/she must successfully complete all of the following Career Technical and academic requirements:

- Earn a "C" average in his/her Career Technical lab
- Earn passing grades in all classes (including elective courses)
- All Credit Recovery courses must be completed
- Earn the required Career Technical credits
- Meet all requirements set forth by the State of Ohio to earn a high school diploma
- All fees need to be paid
- No more than 15 days absence and/or 10 days of out of school suspension per year

Only students who have fulfilled the requirements for a one year or two year Career Technical certificate will be allowed to participate and to be recognized at the Awards Ceremony. **The deadline for students to meet the criteria for participation is by noon on Tuesday, May 10, 2022.** Students who do not meet the Career Technical certificate criteria at that time will not be permitted to participate in the Awards Ceremony. Students who meet the criteria after the deadline date may receive a Career Passport, but may not participate in the Awards Ceremony.

Payment of School Fees

Students must have all Buckeye Career Center school fees paid by Friday, April 29, 2022. Students may not be permitted to participate in the Awards Ceremony if they do not have these fees paid by this date.

Student Dress Requirements and Expectation

The Buckeye Career Center Awards Ceremony is a dignified event and our expectation is that students dress and conduct themselves in that manner. All students participating will wear the cap and gown they are wearing at their home school graduation ceremonies. It is highly recommended that students arrive in the Performing Arts Center wearing their cap and gown; there are no changing rooms available.

No writing, artwork, decorating, etc. is permitted on the mortarboard of the graduation cap.

The attire to be worn under the gown is as follows:

Ladies:

Dress Slacks or Dresses/Skirts (no shorts, no jeans)

Dress Shirt or Blouse

Dress Shoes or Boots (no athletic shoes or flip-flops, and boots must be clean and free of dirt, mud, etc.)

Gentlemen:

Dress Shirt (May be a polo shirt or button down dress shirt; tie optional)

Dress Pants (no shorts, no jeans)

Dress Shoes or Boots (no athletic shoes or flip-flops, and boots must be clean and free of dirt, mud, etc.)

In cases of hardship where students cannot afford the above required dress, please see a member of the administrative staff, and we will ensure that you have the proper attire. ***Students who blatantly disobey the dress or behavior expectations will not participate.***

Parking at Kent State University Performing Arts Center

Students and guests are to park in the parking lot on the south side of the Performing Arts Center.

Awards Ceremony Practice
