### **BCC ADULT EDUCATION STILL ACCEPTING STUDENTS FOR 2018-19 SCHOOL YEAR**

New Philadelphia, OH (July 19, 2018) – Adult Education courses at Buckeye Career Center are set to begin August 28<sup>th</sup> but interested area residents still have time to apply. Applications are being accepted for Cosmetology, Heating, Ventilating, Air Conditioning, & Refrigeration, Heavy Equipment/CDL-A Operator, Medical Assisting (evening only), Medical Office & Billing Specialist, and Utility Lineworker. The programs last nine months, with the exception of Cosmetology (two-year program), and meet during the school year August-May in the day or evening hours, depending on each class. Programs include a 120-150 hour externship in the spring, allowing students to gain experience in a work environment prior to completing their training.

Students enrolled in full-time programs must have a high school diploma or GED, and certain programs have additional admission requirements. Those who qualify may be able to receive federal financial aid and veteran's training assistance. Please contact student services at 1.800.227.1665 or 330.339.2288 to schedule an appointment. Fulltime program orientation is planned for August 22, 2018.

Additionally, short term classes for career enhancement including Machining, AutoCAD, Welding, and Industrial Electricity begin in September. Other part-time courses beginning in the fall include Cake Decorating, Sign Language, Flower Arrangements, and Bee Keeping.
