BUCKEYE CAREER CENTER STUDENTS WIN AWARDS

New Philadelphia, OH (April 3, 2018) – Buckeye Career Center’s Wildlife Management team took second at the Ohio FFA Spring Skills Career Development Event, Saturday, March 24th. The team competed against 72 other Ohio teams at the state level. Placing highest in the individual competition was Gavin Mullen (Strasburg), who claimed first out of 275 competitors. Other students competing included Seth Schuman – 18th (Tusky Valley), Hunter McKim – 31st (Claymont), Katelyn Smitley - 36th (Fairless), Thomas Muster-102nd (Tusky Valley), Justice Hinkel – 118th (New Philadelphia), and Aric Gardner – 122nd (Indian Valley).

Five Family, Career, and Community Leaders of America (FCCLA) members are moving on to the state competition in April. Buckeye Career Center hosted the regional competition March 10, 2018 and was recently notified of the state qualifiers, who will compete April 26-27, 2018 in Columbus.
