BCC PREPARES FOR THE START OF 2018-2019 SCHOOL YEAR

New Philadelphia, OH (July 18, 2018) – It's nearly time to begin the 2018-2019 school year at Buckeye Career Center. The first day for juniors and new students is Monday, August 20 and returning students begin Tuesday, August 21. Both days begin at 7:50am and end at 2:25pm. Juniors and new students will be treated to the annual "Buckeye Palooza," an event that features inflatables, food, and games for new students to interact with their classmates and instructors.

Ahead of the first day of school, Buckeye will host its annual high school orientation Wednesday, August 15, 2017 from 12:30-7:30pm for all high school students. Students and their families can stop by at any time during that time period. Class schedules will be distributed and students will also be able to get their student identification photo taken, register for a parking permit (will need license plate number and \$5.00 registration fee), pay fees, receive a copy of the dress code and code of conduct, get login information for student grade information, receive assistance with online student forms and have questions answered before school starts. BCC will provide free hand-dipped ice cream for students and their families.

Student fees and lunch account payments for the 2018-19 school year may be made with cash, check or credit card at Buckeye Career Center during orientation or anytime in the treasurer's office. Payments can also be made online using PayForIt.net, which is BCC's online partner for paying fees and adding money to a student's lunch account. Please note that fee amounts will not appear on PayForIt until mid-August. Students who chose to pay for their lunch daily can still do so at the cashier station in the cafeteria. Breakfast and lunch prices remain the same from the 2017-18 school year. Student breakfast is \$2.25 and student lunch \$3.25.
