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**BUCKEYE CAREER CENTER TO REMAIN IN BLENDED LEARNING
MODEL FOR TWO MORE WEEKS**

New Philadelphia, OH (October 22, 2020) – In response to the COVID-19 health pandemic, Buckeye Career Center is announcing that the school will remain in a blended learning model, for two additional weeks, through November 6, 2020. School began in August in the current blended learning model, as well.

The blended learning model features instruction through in-person and remote learning each week. The schedule remains the same with seniors attending in-person October 26, 27, 28 and November 2 and 3. Juniors will attend in-person October 29 and 30 and November 4, 5, and 6th. Students are expected to participate in remote academic learning on the days they are not in-person at school. “We feel this is the best model as we strive to maintain our social distance and provide a safe environment for our students and staff,” stated BCC Superintendent Bob Alsept. “We continue to monitor the health of our students and staff, as well as, the health of our partner schools,” he said.
