Dear School Community,

Buckeye Career Center is committed to the safety and health of our students and staff. We want to inform you that Buckeye Career Center will begin remote instruction on Monday, November 23, 2020 through Friday, December 4, 2020. Although we have had no known transmission within our building, this change is due to the rise in positive COVID cases and quarantines. Buckeye Career Center plans to return to our blended learning model beginning Monday, December 7, 2020.

Buckeye Career Center's return to the blended learning model the week of December 7-11 is as follows:

Seniors (Level II): Monday, December 7 - Wednesday, December 9
Juniors (Level I): Thursday, December 10 - Friday, December 11

During the period of remote instruction, students will be expected to complete daily online assignments. Teaching staff will be available during normal school hours and days to assist students. Students in need of supplies (i.e. chromebook) to complete remote instruction should contact the main office at 330-339-2288 for assistance. Lunches will be available for students to be picked up at Buckeye Career Center as needed.

Buckeye Career Center is working closely with the Tuscarawas County Health Department and will continue to monitor how COVID impacts our school prior to making any further decisions. It is the district's desire to have face to face learning, but the number one concern is to keep everyone safe and healthy.
